

#### Young Communicator's Award

• Stage 2 (Years 3 and 4): 1 ½ - 2 ½ minutes

• Stage 3 (Years 5 and 6): 3-4 minutes

#### Music as Release from Face to Face (RFF)



Music lessons this semester are focussing on timbre or tone colour of both musical instruments and voice. Last semester students engaged with singing, moving and playing activities while learning about beat and rhythm, dynamics (loud and soft or volume), pitch (the highs and lows of sound) and tempo (the speed of music). These elements are all still referred to while learning about timbre.
