

### **Grounds Works**

We are now nearing completion of the hydrant replacement works on our school site. The 2 tanks and pumphouse have been installed. Pressure testing of the new hydrants and decommissioning of the old hydrants remains before Adlers Building finishes on our site.

Once hand over has occurred, Ezertec Building will come on site to complete remediation and repair works across the site, returning our school grounds to the high standards we aspire to. We are excited to have Ezertec complete these works, as they have successfully completed projects to a high standard across our site, eg the new seats around the K-2 playground tree, library renovations and our amphitheatre space.

Additionally, Dynasaw Arborists have been engaged to remove one of our very large gum trees, which was damaged during excavation for the water tanks.

Our walk way to the oval has been newly turfed, so that by the time the safety fencing goes, we should have a nice entry/exit way from the school.

# **Wollongbar Public School Cross Country**

When: Thursday 2nd May 2024 (Term 2, Week 1)

Where: The track will begin and finish on Hill Park Oval with students running a newly

designed track around Hill Park Oval.

\*\*The hill on Hill Park Oval will be the best place to observe and cheer on all

students. Social distancing must be followed.

**Who:** 5, 6, 7 years old this year will run one complete lap -1 km.

8, 9, 10 years old this year will run 2 laps – 2 kms. 11, 12, 13 years this year will run 3 laps – 3 kms.

Students will run in age divisions, determined by the age they turn this year.
